# 1. OPENING

- HPCSA registration of the coursework, training requirements and assessment of competence for the Medical Technologist qualification in Cell Biology with its two subsections of "Tissue Banking" and "Cell & Gene Therapy".

Previous meeting (15/9/2020) we discussed training. Dr Brittain spoke to E2 and our website can host this. Dr Brittain made a video on how to make a presentation video, this will be distributed to members who we will ask to do a presentation and add questions at the end which can be done afterwards electronically.
